In this forum, we heard from Georgie Harman, CEO of Beyond Blue on the importance of supporting employee wellbeing as a strategic priority in our workplaces.

We also heard employees share their lived experience of managing wellbeing, and how the intersectionality of our identities uniquely shapes our experiences.

In this forum, we heard a keynote from Dr Rae Cooper and Dr Liz Hill from Sydney University Gender Equality in Working Life Research Initiative. They also explored gaps and policy levers, with a focus on flexible work.

Antiracism – April 2023 ▼

This forum aimed to equip diversity and inclusion practitioners with the knowledge and skills to advocate for anti-racism in their agencies and to apply the thinking to their existing inclusion and workforce management strategies.

Keynote speaker Mr Chin Tan, former Race Discrimination Commissioner from the Australian Human Rights Commission (AHRC), spoke about the National Anti-Racism Framework and the importance of taking action against racism to create a safer and more inclusive workplace and society. Sector agencies shared their best practices and resource from the Australian Human Rights Commission “Racism. It Stops With Me” campaign were shared.
